

## Camp Rules

### These rules apply to all campers:

1. No one may to leave camp without permission from the camp Director.
2. Flint Hills is a fine campground; let's keep it clean, neat, attractive – and always Christian.
3. Hiking is permitted only in groups that have a staff member in charge.
4. **Do not bring these items: cell phones (see note below), MP3 players or iPods, musical instruments, tobacco, alcohol, matches, fireworks, knives, firearms, radios, CD or tape players, any electronic games, or water canons.**
5. Profane, vulgar and unbecoming language and actions will not be tolerated.
6. **All clothing must be worn to the knees. This includes jams, shorts, dresses, etc. No spandex, sun dresses or see-through shirts. All clothing must cover the midriff and armpits! Check slogans and advertisements on shirts to make sure they are of a Christian nature. There will be no tolerance of unacceptable attire.**
7. Camp life is group-centered. Therefore, there must not be any display of affection between campers. There will be no splitting off from the main group.
8. Absolutely NO HORSEPLAY! None will be tolerated. No pushing or shoving others.
9. Boys and girls are to stay away from “opposite” cabins.
10. Stay away from the pool area unless it's your turn to swim.
11. No campers in the dining hall unless staff authorized. **The kitchen is off limits to campers!**
12. Do not borrow anything without the owner's permission. “You break, you pay.” Parents will be notified.
13. Report lost items, and turn in found items to the director immediately.
14. Each cabin will be inspected for cleanliness and orderliness each day.
15. Rest hour must be observed. Be on your bunk resting, studying or reading.
16. Lights must be out as scheduled and **QUIET!** Campers must stay in cabins.
17. Campers must stay away from parked cars.
18. No use of the telephone without permission from the Camp Director.
19. No visitors may spend the night on Friday night.
20. Further guidelines will be provided by the Director upon arrival at camp.

**Special note regarding cell phones:** If you bring a cell phone to camp, it will be confiscated by the Camp Director or Counselors until the end of the camp session. **Parents, please do not send a cell phone with your child. If he / she needs to contact you, the Director will provide access to the camp telephone. You may contact your child through the Camp Director via the camp telephone (620-725-3822).**

## Flint Hills Christian Camp

The campground is located 3 miles north of Sedan on Highway 99. The facilities include a dining hall, boys' and girls' dorms (each holding 45 campers), worship areas, swimming pool, three large areas for sports, and hiking trails. Activities include worship, Bible classes, singing classes, devotionals, swimming, sports hiking, and interaction with others in a Christian environment. Friendships are made that often last a lifetime!

*Jesus Christ is Lord at Flint Hills Christian Camp, and we want to glorify him and edify each other in all we do together. Obeying the camp rules will help our camp reflect the image of Christ. Please read all the rules.*

### What to bring:

- Bible
- Paper
- Pens/pencils
- Envelopes

**Clothing:** This is a Christian camp. All clothing **must be appropriate!** (note rule #6) You will need *dress clothes for worship, play clothes for sports, and sleeping attire.*

## Pre-registration

*All campers should pre-register.* Early registration allows directors, counselors and cooks to be better prepared to serve our campers. Therefore, *anyone who pre-registers before June 15<sup>th</sup> will pay the discounted camp fee of \$90. Campers who register after June 15<sup>th</sup> and those who do not register prior to camp will pay an additional \$25 late fee for a total of \$115.* The \$15 deposit must accompany all pre-registrations. Registrations will be accepted on a "first-come, first served" basis. *We cannot guarantee a place for late registrations.*

Registration will be completed at the camp from 3:00 to 4:30 p.m. on the first day of camp. Please do not arrive before 3:00 p.m. At this time, the balance of the camp fee will be due (\$75 for pre-registrations before June 15<sup>th</sup>; \$100 for registrations after June 15<sup>th</sup>; \$115 for those not pre-registered). At registration, each camper will also be assigned to a counselor who will help with camp activities for the week.

## Discipline

Each camper is expected to help in keeping discipline through cooperation with all staff. Without good discipline, they cannot discharge the camp's primary function of guiding the Christian development of each camper. Anyone who will not obey instructions will be asked to go home.

## Notice For Parents

- Each camper has the personal attention of his or her group counselor (6-8 campers per group).
- Complete medical facilities are available in Sedan, just 4 miles away.
- All staff members, counselors, Bible teachers and support staff members are members in good standing of the church of Christ.
- No camper is allowed to leave campgrounds without the Camp Director's permission. If a camper must leave for sports or other activities, please return that camper before 10 p.m., or after 7 a.m. the next day.
- Visitors are welcome! Come see the camp and its activities. Join us for worship in the evening (check with the camp director for worship times). **[Notice: No visitor may spend the night on Friday night. All visitors are subject to all camp rules.]**
- **Registration begins at 3 p.m. Sunday.**
- **Camp will end mid-morning Saturday. Please pick up your child by 10 a.m.!**
